USM Student Beaten on Greek Row

HATTIESBURG – USM freshman Stuart Ramsey <u>recuperating in his Jackson home</u> today after having been badly beaten on the USM campus on Saturday evening. Ramsey's father, Tom, told *The Hattiesburg American* that Stuart, who is 18, suffered (1) a broken hand, (2) a concussion, (3) numerous lacerations, (4) numerous bruises, and (5) multiple boot prints as a result of being attacked from behind by members of USM's Sigma Phi Epsilon fraternity. USM police chief Bob Hopkins informed *THA* that no suspects had been developed yet. From that point Hopkins refused to provide additional information about the episode.

Stuart Ramsey, shown below, was treated on 4-Dec-2010 in the emergency room at Forrest General Hospital – the same facility wherein three USM football players who were shot outside a notorious Hattiesburg nightclub were recently treated – and admitted for overnight observation before being released on 5-Dec-2010.



Sources tell USMNEWS.net that the Ramsey case could conceivably rise to a felony, given the severity of Ramsey's injuries and other aspects reported to *THA* about the case. It seems clear today, according to sources, that the Ramseys are not going to let this case become stale.
