

What did UW-W Get for Its Money?

Reporters at usmnews.net continue to review records provided by colleagues at UW-W detailing Dr. Saunders' use of UW-W and UW-W Foundation resources. Of particular interest to readers has been an expensive trip to London, England. While usmnews.net reporters cannot confirm that the receipts are complete or exhaustive, they continue to raise eyebrows as well as questions.

A [purchase card record](#) submitted by Dr. Saunders identifies the following expenditures, apparently billed to UW-W:

The purchase card does not identify what was charged to the Red Carnation to the tune of \$2118.43 (deducting the credit), nor were any receipts attached to the documents provided to usmnews.net. However, based on the receipts usmnews.net was able to obtain, which don't include the Red Carnation bills, it still appears that Dr. Saunders and the First Husband enjoyed the best of everything.
