What is the Quality of USM's MBA Program?

Carefully crafted representations made by USM must be carefully assessed. As indicated in the multitude of reports contained on usmnews.net's webpage, USM does not have a stellar reputation for quality or candor.

Consider a recent <u>USM PR report</u>, "University of Southern Mississippi to Offer Online Classes for MBA Program." "Earlier this year the Southern Miss MBA program was included among the nation's Top 200 part-time business programs in rankings for 2014 by U.S. News & World Report... 'The Southern Miss MBA is a nationally competitive program that offers our students options to tailor courses to their needs,' said Dr. Faye Gilbert, dean of the College of Business at Southern Miss."

Note that USM's MBA program is NOT in the top 200 business programs. USM's MBA program is "not ranked." Furthermore, it does not report "average GMAT score (full-time) nor acceptance rate (full-time). Why? Because to report these measures of program quality would demonstrate just how poor USM's MBA program is.
